

QuickClaim V.3.1.4 [Upgrade From V.2.2.3] Feature Sheet – Official\* Release 21/12/2009:

\*Beta release August 2009.

General:

- Claims
  - o Claim Screen handles multiple Premium Codes.
  - o Full explanation and MOH Claim number pop up with mouse over in the Rejected Claims Window.
- Label printing is now independent of third party software such as Dymo. This opens the door to label printing across networks and devices other than Dymo label printers.
- New Fields added to Quick.Service.Codes
  - o number of services per OHIP service code within each Quick.Service.Code. also applicable to bilateral procedure billing.
  - o Limitless number of OHIP service codes with a Meta-Quick.Service.Code
  - o colour code for distinct display in the appointment book
  - o Length of procedure for appointment length with a total time function
  - o Full Description field display for user interaction
- EDT
  - o Added routines to handle new telephony technologies.
  - o Password can be set to change automatically, as frequently as every login or chosen number of days.
  - o TCPIP for EDT and Health Card Validation [see Subscription Services]
- Appointment Book
  - o Added start time and end time on the daily view to minimize scrolling
  - o Added appointment count to the daily appointment Window
  - o Added an option for a wider patient name search in appointments
  - o Appointment Label including notes for back of visiting card
- Card swiping now attempts to look for possible matches for misspelled names in the appointments and patients tables.
- General Patient Window lists Family and Referring doctor address in addition to names
- Added mouse wheel functionality to the Claims and Past Claims Windows.
- Report of active and inactive patients for n months back
- Past Claims report of recent most claim per patient without patient duplication.
- Added Options F9:
  - o not to carry referring doctor and admit date over to future claims
  - o back button after save on patient and claim screens
  - o general purpose patient flag
  - o warning for missing DOB, referring doctor and sex in general patient Window
  - o enable/disable name update after card swipe
  - o enter key saves appointment details [double enter to save appointment]
  - o “?” icon in Patient General Window accesses Referring Doctors Window
- MOH Mandates
  - o APP with modifier and trigger codes [i.e. NS APP; alternative payment plan at Sudbury Regional OHIP Office Claims Payment Division; introduced Oct. 2009].
  - o “L” file reconciliation capable as an upgrade to Technical Bulletin - Data Link09-007. QuickClaim EDT reconciliation now processes XML reports. Currently MOH sends two reports an “Enrolment Report Patient Summary Number” and an “Outside Use Report (Patients with Signed Consent)”.

## Subscription Services:

- Patient workflow options involving the Swipe Card, General Patient, Patient History, Appointment Book and Claims Window.
- Complete HL7 Engine for third party EMR integration
- AutoSplit and manual claim splitting via a provider profile to profile setup, or based on a series of SQL statements, to allow extensive customization per facility, and service codes.
- Appointment book
  - o Viewing for appointments made by third party HL7
  - o App Details displays Quick.Service.Codes color codes additive effect for appointment length of multi service code Quick Service Codes.
  - o Record keeping of procedure study numbers
- Health Card Validation
  - o TCPIP Real time EDT and Health Card Validation
  - o Over night [OBEC] from the Daily Appointments Window.
  - o AutoOBEC before the 4pm daily dead line.
- Physician work sheets and forms print directly from the Patient General Window
- Third party bulk invoicing
- Past Claims
  - o Search options by empty provider field, batchid, claim status, invoices, facility, and separately by third party.
  - o Third party bulk invoicing
- Two sizes of bag label printing in automatic and manual modes

- 3 full-featured HL7 EMRs:
  - QuickDOCS an Encounter Documentation Manager with an accompanying MSWord tool bar, ideal for fast paced Walk-in and Specialist practice [see data sheet online].
    - o MSWord tool bar includes document autobackup, error reporting and end of day document reconciliation.
    - o MSWord tool bar user interface, left to right:



1. Create a PDF and deposit it in QuickFile
  2. Keep as a .DOC and deposit it in QuickFile
  3. Create a PDF and file it directly to QuickDOCS
  4. Paste any Doctor from referring Doctors table
  5. Replace any data base tags in autocorrect
  6. Create an attachment to fax/email, and file it directly to QuickDOCS
  7. Print to dedicated printer
  8. Choose default printer
  9. Choose printer
  10. Date for new page
  11. Enter
  12. Undo
  13. Exit

  - QSS QuickClaim Secure Server, for networking your QuickClaim computer over WAN/LAN/Internet, now has dedicated printing support with "Universal Printer".
  - QuickClaim/DOCS Reports Web server [HTTPS] for web access only networks [ie.hospitals]
